

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE PEOPLE'S CONSULTANTS  
(a Not-for-Profit Corporation)

We, the undersigned, being natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more and citizens of the United States, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the "General Not-for-Profit Corporation Law" of the State of Missouri, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is The People's Consultants.

ARTICLE II.

The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The names and addresses of the incorporators are:

ARTICLE IV.

The number of directors constituting the first Board of Directors is three and the names and addresses of the first directors to hold office are:

ARTICLE V.

The address of its initial registered office in the State of Missouri is 436a North Sappington Road, St. Louis, Missouri 63122. The name of its initial registered agent is Mrs. Louise Clemens.

ARTICLE VI.

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational, civic, social welfare, research, and health purposes, and in furtherance thereof shall have the power to do the following:

1. To construct technically adequate water systems in impoverished communities in the Central American Country of Guatemala and other Latin American Countries, taking into consideration the cultural, sociological, and economic characteristics of each community.
2. To train Latin Americans in the design and construction of rural water systems.
3. To outline and refine the methodology for designing and constructing rural water systems in order to develop a model which can effectively be used world-wide.
4. To initiate a comprehensive evaluation of the water systems which this corporation constructs so that the design and construction of future systems will be continually improved.
5. To educate the communities in which the water systems are constructed so that they will be able to independently operate and maintain the new water facility.
6. To encourage further community development in the respective communities in which the water systems have been introduced.
7. To engage in the supervision, operation and administration of funds and properties for charitable, educational, civic, social

welfare, research, and health purposes.

8. To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise to acquire and to own, hold, use or otherwise deal in and with any real or personal property or any interest therein situated in or out of the State of Missouri as may be necessary and proper for carrying on the purposes of this corporation.


9. To receive and take by gift, grant, assignment, transfer, devise or bequest any real or personal property, in trust, for any charitable, educational, civic, social welfare, research, or health purposes.


10. To make, contract and incur liabilities which may be appropriate to make or to accomplish any and all of its purposes; to borrow money for its corporate purposes at such rate of interest as the corporation may determine.

11. To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to affect any or all of the purposes for which this corporation is organized except that this corporation shall not engage in any activities not permitted for an organization qualified under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

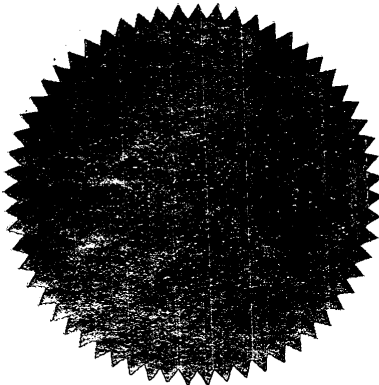
